PUNJAB, PAKISTAN

Punjab is a geopolitical, cultural, and historical region in South Asia, specifically in the northern part of the Indian subcontinent, comprising areas of eastern Pakistan and northern India.

Punjab state has 22 districts and its population in 2020 is estimated to be 30 Million; Muslims constitute just under 2% of the total population in Punjab.

ANJUMAN SAMAJI BEHBOOD

Anjuman Samaji Behbood (ASB) which social welfare means organisation was established in 1964 non-profit as а Non-Government Organization (NGO) and registered in 1975 under the Directorate of Social Welfare, government of Punjab. The charity started its activities with a profile of general welfare activities and also currently is helping communities living in low income settlements install underground piping to channel sewage to the main municipal sewage line. ASB wants to make people self-reliant instead of dependent on projects and has opened a way to build co-ordination, sustainable cohesiveness and create a sense of ownership in communities and at all levels of government.

THE NEED

Inflation and prices are increasing daily in Punjab and Pakistan as a whole and this is resulting in the poor becoming poorer. Unemployment is very high and in the villages there are many young people who do not have work and are therefore unable to support their families.

INCOME GENERATION SCHEME

This scheme, which is already running, aims to give those who are struggling financially the seeds to earn a livelihood of their own, thereby empowering them with the tools for their own success. ASB focus on very remote and deprived areas of Pakistan where the Shia population is dense; the scheme enables beneficiaries to grow and start a new life.

The scheme is operating under strict terms and condition and loans will only be provided to those people who are able to follow ASB's rules and regulations.


The scheme provides loans so that beneficiaries can buy items to start small businesses such as book shops, fruit shops, tuck shops and other small shops for women at home.

CASE STUDIES

Names have been changed to protect beneficiary dignity.

Mustafa is a resident of Hasoo Bulail village. He has four children, 3 daughters and one son. His one daughter is crippled. He was a labourer in his early life but with the passage of time and age he is now unable to do hard labour. His family were extremely concerned about the financial risk and where money will come from.

He had applied to Anjuman Samaji Behbood for some financial assistance. Now this time, after approval from WF-AID and with thanks to the generous donor, he is provided with assistance. Now has got a hand driven cart for his earning and daily works. He goes to the vegetable and fruit market every day and brings some crates of fresh produce to sell on the road. He is earning and his family now feel comfortable knowing there is an income.
