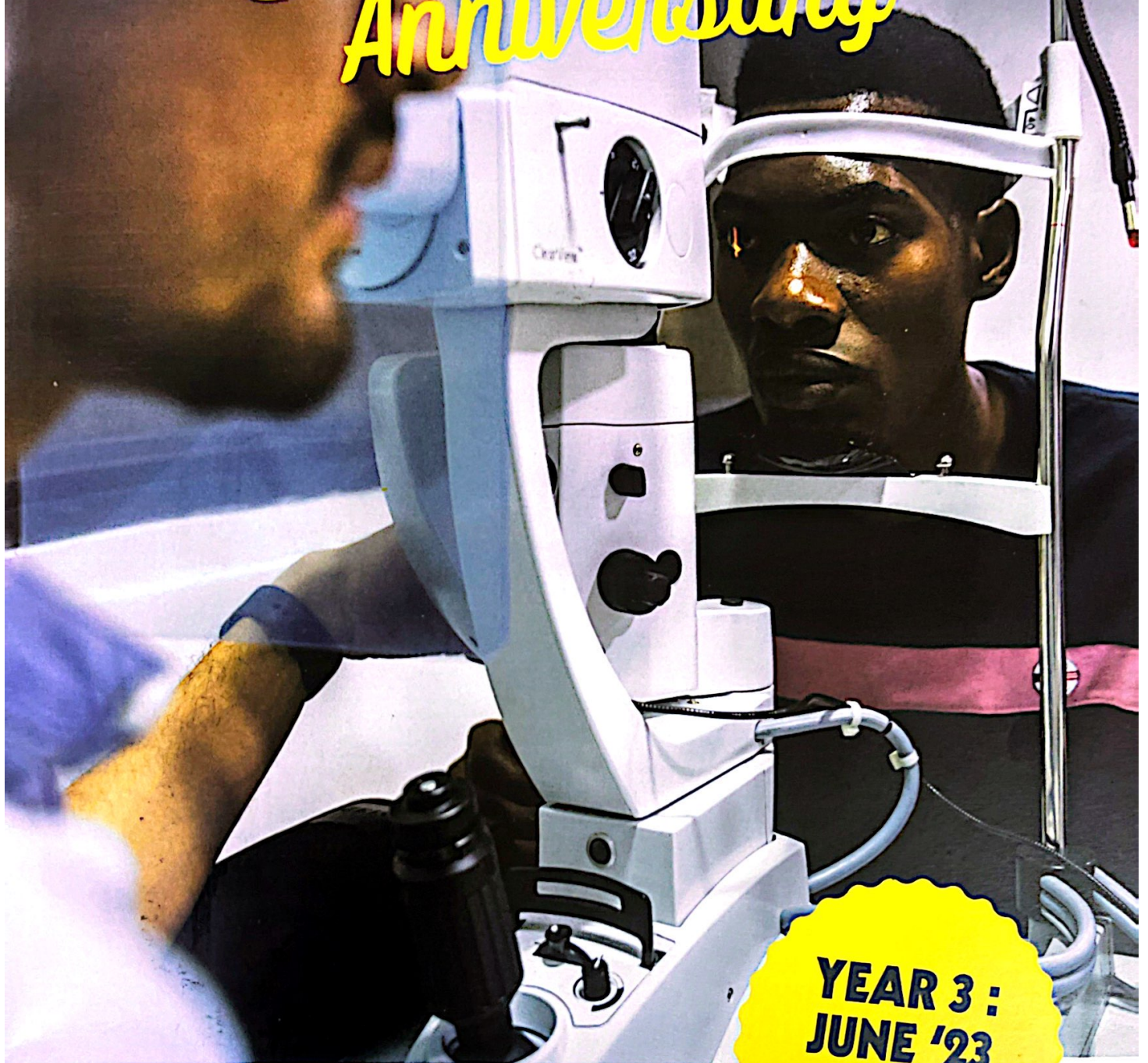

Today,

we are very happy to celebrate Eid-Mubahela and our 3rd Anniversary. Wishes and congratulations to you all.

We warmly welcome everyone to celebrate with us today. Our facilities are open to all, regardless of background, creed or beliefs.

Allow me to take you back to 2021, when a group of us, under the leadership of Alhaj Anver Merali Alibhai and his wife, Ms. Anver Merali (popularly known as Alia KEKI), decided to launch an Eye Centre in Dar es Salaam during a meal at home.

It was known that KSI Jamaat of Dar es Salaam had a disused building at Temeke, previously used as a dispensary. We approached KSIJ of Dar es Salaam, and through the then Presidentship of Alhaj Azim Alibhai, they agreed to give us the building free of charge on the condition that we would renovate it without drawing on the Centre's Treasury or for re-current expenses.

Inspired by faith and the generosity of our community, we embarked on a mission to establish our Eye Centre. Thanks to their financial support, we opened our doors in June 2021, fully equipped to serve our patients. On that very day, we performed 6 surgeries in our brand new, state-of-the-art operating room, generously funded by the Mohsin & Fauzia Jaffer Foundation of the U.S.A. (through the World Bank).

May Allah SWT bless our donors who helped us meet the tough standards of the Ministry of Health and fully equipped the theatre.

From that humble beginning, we are proud to announce our statistics over the past 3 years:

- Patients Registered: 35,400
- Patient Visits and Revisits: 79,368
- Patients Operated: 3,853
- Patients Given Spectacles: 11,680
- OCT Consultations: 534

Our current payroll includes:

- 3 Ophthalmologists
- 4 Optometrists
- 8 Nurses
- 1 Pharmacist
- 18 Support Staff

Dr. Mudassir Alloo operates our state-of-the-art Optical Coherence Tomography (OCT) and the latest 2nd Generation Visulas Yag III Combi SLT (Combi) machines. In our Souvenir, you will find detailed information about these advanced devices. The OCT machine was generously donated by Dr. Ahmed Hassam through W.F., who also contributed to the Combi machine alongside Beta Charitable Trust of the U.K. Additionally, Dr. Ahmed Hassam made a donation for ophthalmology room equipment in memory of his family. We warmly welcome Dr. Ahmed Hassam and express our gratitude for his invaluable support.

CHAIRMAN'S MESSAGE

Initial use of this Combi has enabled us to detect cases of Glaucoma, potentially relieving patients from using costly medicines.

To ensure sustainability, we are launching an appeal for donations for an "ENDOWMENT FUND." Individual donations are capped at \$5,000 (Tsh.14m), and Corporate Donors at \$25,000 (Tsh.70m). Our Managing Committee has already donated \$25,000 towards this Fund. We aim to raise \$2m for the Endowment Fund to cover recurrent expenses.

Over the past year, we established a partnership with Tigo, whose CEO, Mr. Kamal Okba, is our Chief Guest today. Tigo funded the construction of the ground floor of a container porta cabin, with the first floor funded by an anonymous donor. Additionally, Tigo has committed to sponsoring four Free Eye Camps in 2024.

Camps have already been held in Zanzibar and Mtwara/Mikindani, benefiting thousands of people. This partnership with Tigo is ongoing, and we look forward to its continuation in 2025 and beyond. Kamal, even if you wish to part ways, we won't let you go. Your regular support is essential to us.

An overseas donor has generously donated Plot No. 154, Mahonda Street. Architects have prepared preliminary drawings for a ground plus four-story building. We aim to raise the necessary funds through various donors, with each donor contributing towards one floor of the building.

Thank you to all our donors, institutions like WF, AFED, KSI Jamaat of DSM, BETA Charitable Trust, Mohsin & Fauzia Charitable Foundation, Mainstay Charitable Foundation, Tigo, Khalid Islamic Foundation (Bakhresa), and our many anonymous donors.

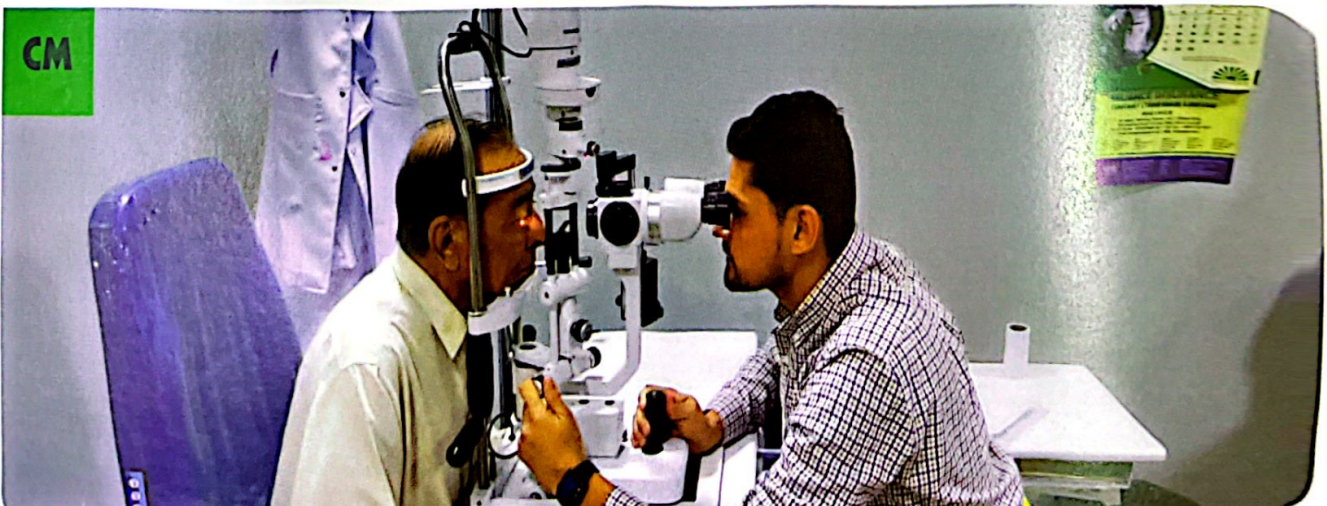

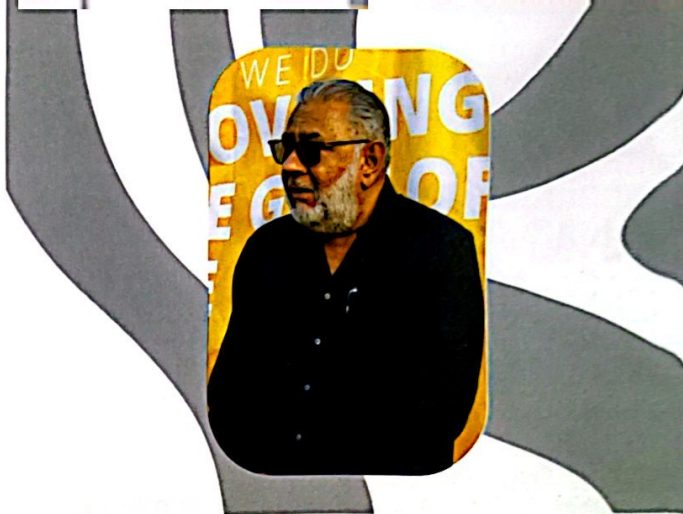
Salaam Alaykum,

OUR UNIQUE TRIAGE PROCESS

An effective tool in identifying undiagnosed cases of diabetes, glaucoma, and hypertension that have a direct impact on eye health and vision.

The 5-step triage system is a systematic approach to assessing patients' medical history and symptoms in order to prioritize their care based on the severity of their condition. In the context of eye health, this system can be particularly useful in identifying individuals with underlying conditions such as diabetes, glaucoma, or hypertension which may not have been diagnosed but have the potential to cause significant damage to the eyes and vision

- **The first step** involves performing a visual acuity test to assess the patient's current level of vision.
- **The second step** involves checking the patient's blood pressure.
- **The third step** involves checking the blood sugar.
- **The fourth step** is checking the eye pressure.
- **The fifth stage** involves referring patients to the optometrists or ophthalmologist.

In summary, a 5-step triage system is an essential tool in identifying undiagnosed cases of diabetes, glaucoma, and hypertension that have a direct impact on eye health and vision. By taking a thorough medical history, performing visual acuity tests, checking blood pressure, examining the eyes, and referring patients for further evaluation when necessary, healthcare professionals can help prevent complications from these conditions and preserve patients' vision.



LASER THERAPY AT KSI CHARITABLE EYE CENTRE FROM DIAGNOSIS TO THERAPEUTIC HOPE ILLUMINATED WITH AFFORDABLE THERAPY

Last year, The KSICEC embarked on a special journey to expand its services beyond optometry and cataract surgeries. With the purchase of the highly sophisticated Optical Coherence Tomography with Angiography (OCT-A), we aimed at setting a benchmark in ocular diagnostics.



Alhamdulillah our DIAGNOSTIC UNIT picked up pace rather quickly and the OCT-A helped us a lot in ocular diagnostics and management. Due to availability, accessibility and affordability, we also received referrals from other eye centres, for those patients who due to poverty were unable to access this service at private clinics.

However, there was something missing. Many of our patients had to be referred to higher centres for management of other ocular pathologies diagnosed with the OCT-A. To address these challenges, we decided to establish our THERAPEUTIC UNIT with one of the finest and most efficient lasers in the market- The Carl Zeiss VISULAS COMBI with SLT. The Carl Zeiss VISULAS COMBI with SLT is a compact workstation for retina, cataract and glaucoma workflows. It is the first fully integrated therapeutic laser workstation offering SLT, photodisruption and photocoagulation technology without compromise.

LASER THERAPY AT KSI CHARITABLE EYE CENTRE

The laser has a combination of three modules hence the name COMBI.

- Visulas YAG
- Visulas Green
- Visulas Green with SLT

This laser is a game changer in the ophthalmic industry. Currently, it's the only laser of its kind in Tanzania.

The major conditions that we were receiving that can now be addressed through the Laser Therapy to save/retain/restore vision are:

- **After Cataract:** We are receiving patients who had been operated for cataracts more than a year ago at our centre or elsewhere with complaints of reduced vision in the operated eye, thinking that the cataract has developed again. In fact, this condition is common after a cataract surgery and is commonly known as "after cataract". The Visulas YAG option seamlessly manages this secondary cataract allowing patients to recover their once lost vision.
- **Glaucoma:** We were also facing challenges with managing patients with high eye pressure (Glaucoma) since compliance and cost of medicines was a huge hindrance for low-income patients. Glaucoma is the leading cause of irreversible blindness in the world. The economic and social burden of this disease is staggering. At KSICEC, we have multiple accounts of patients who have lost vision in both eyes due to this condition. The main reason being unawareness and/or non affordability as the condition requires use of eye drops on a daily basis. Often, treatment is delayed due to financial reasons. This makes it even worse since blindness is a disability that makes people financially dependent thereby affecting their social life.

After seeing so many patients suffer from this condition, we now offer Selective Laser Trabeculoplasty (SLT) as first line treatments for Glaucoma and Ocular Hypertension. SLT has been shown to effectively reduce eye pressure by 30%. It is most beneficial for those who have never used any eye drops. However, it can also help supplement eye drops and reduce the medical therapy cost for the patient. The glaucoma patients that we encounter at our centre are usually very advanced. Patients are usually on maximum medical therapy without achieving target pressures. SLT will help us in achieving pressures that are within the target for each patient.

- **Diabetic Retinopathy:** Perhaps the standout of retinal pathologies that we see at KSICEC is Diabetic Retinopathy. Our unique 5 step triage helps a lot in picking up incidental diabetics. However, we also see patients with diabetic eye disease who do not even know that they have diabetes. Uncontrolled and longstanding Diabetes causes great damage to the retina, that if not diagnosed and managed early, can lead to irreversible blindness. With OCT-A, we manage to effectively understand the extent of the damage done. Now with our new laser, we can treat these patients and help halt further loss of vision, and save them from journeying into irreversible blindness. Unfortunately, the vision lost cannot be restored.

YOUR DONATIONS AND SUPPORT HELP TO HALT FURTHER BLINDNESS



Patients scheduled for surgery frequently present themselves with high eye pressure, high blood sugar or high blood pressure. This poses a challenge for the surgeon who ultimately delays the surgery until all parameters are normal.

With the advent of our recently introduced **Glaucoma, Diabetic and Hypertensive clinic**, we hope to tackle these silent killers. All these conditions affect eye sight with Glaucoma and Diabetes being the most common causes of blindness globally.

Treatment of Diabetic eye disease is often costly and not very accessible. With the newly installed Laser at KSICEC, we can ensure that our patients receive timely and subsidized treatments and follow ups thereby preventing further vision loss.

Additional laser therapies:

Laser Iridotomy: It's an ophthalmic emergency and causes severe pain and loss of vision. In this, the drainage pathway is blocked anatomically. Laser therapy created an alternate pathway for the fluid inside the eye to pass thereby reducing the pressure and preventing further damage to the eye

Laser Vitreolysis: This procedure is used to treat large floaters that are located at the center of the visual field.

The above therapies are not only costly but also scarce in many eye clinics.

Since its inception, The KSICEC has encountered big challenge in the form of Glaucoma, diabetes and Hypertension.

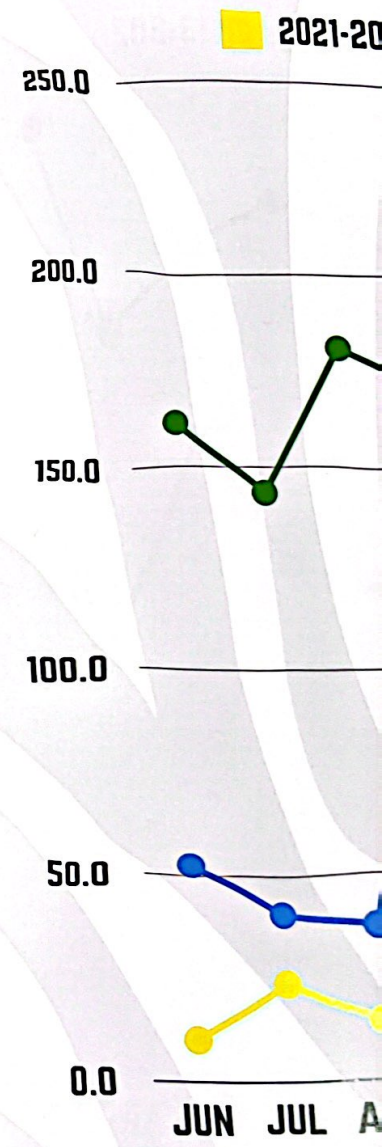
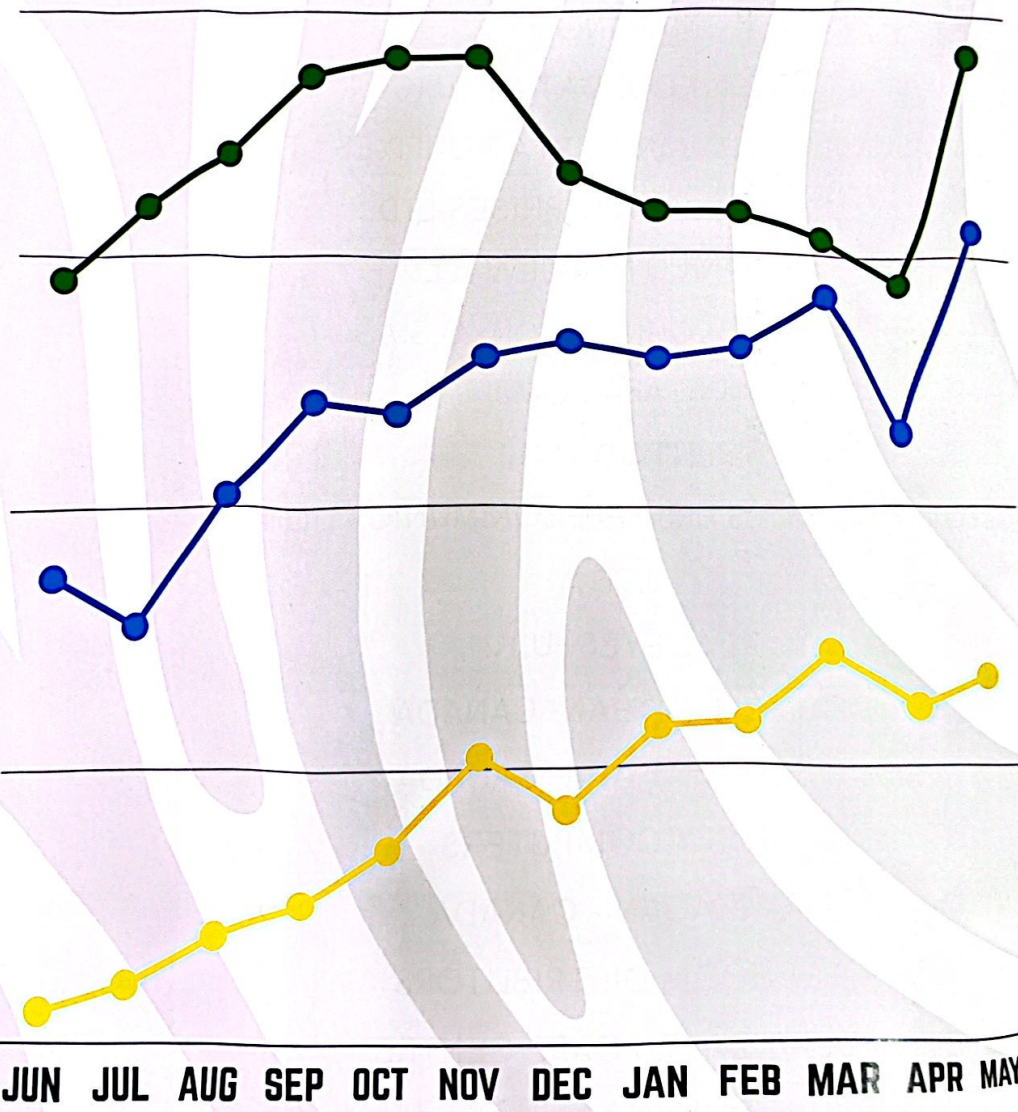

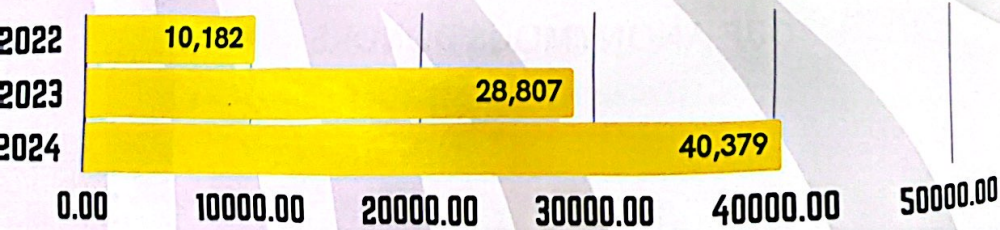
STATISTICS OF PATIENTS SEEN FROM JUNE 2021 - MAY 2024

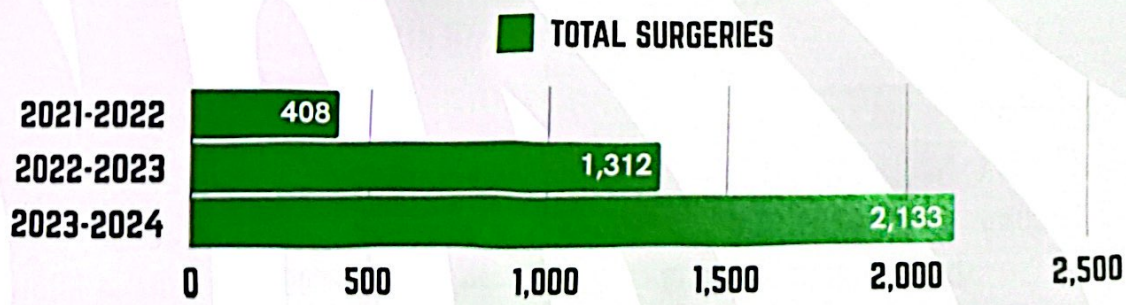
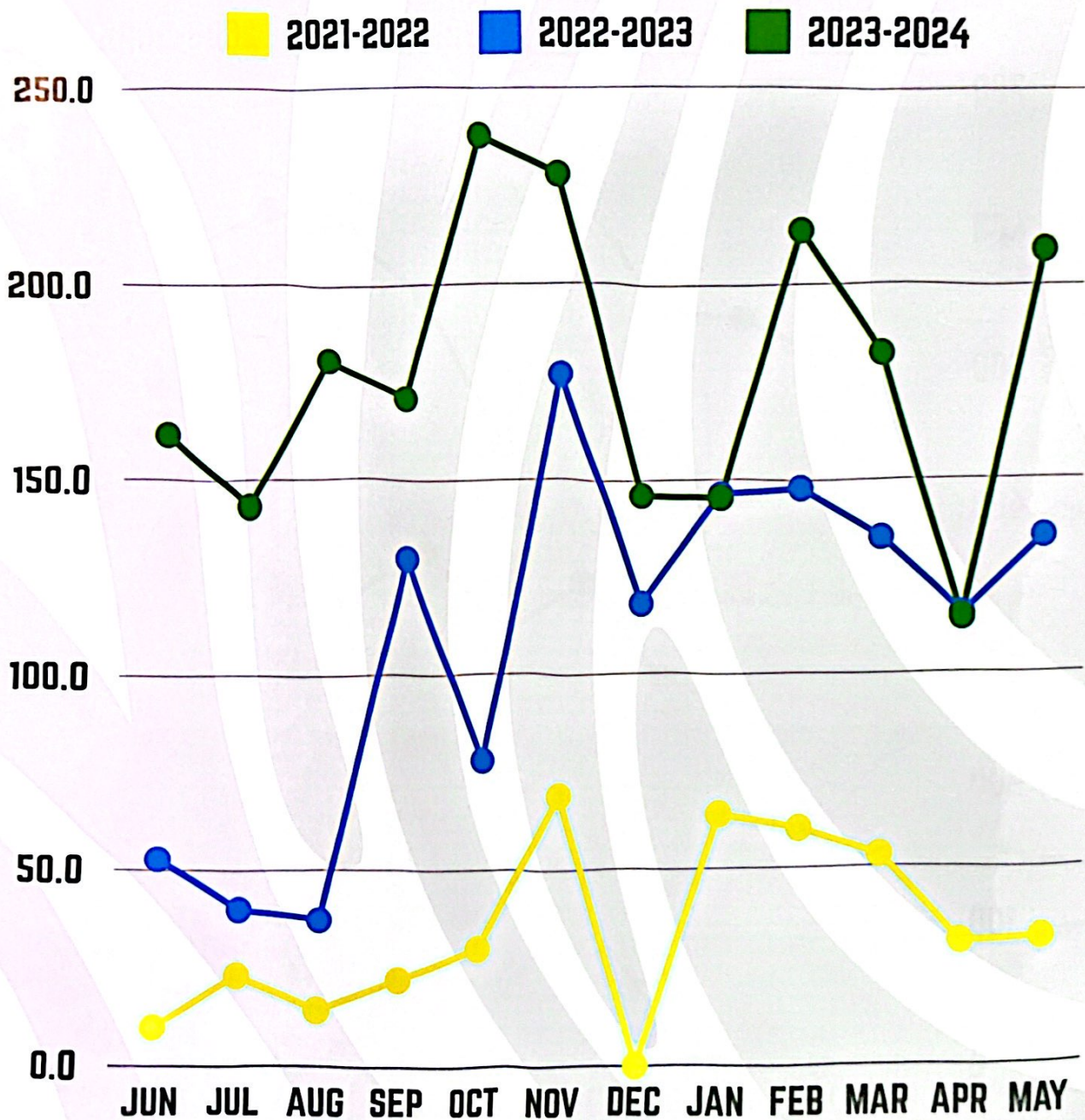

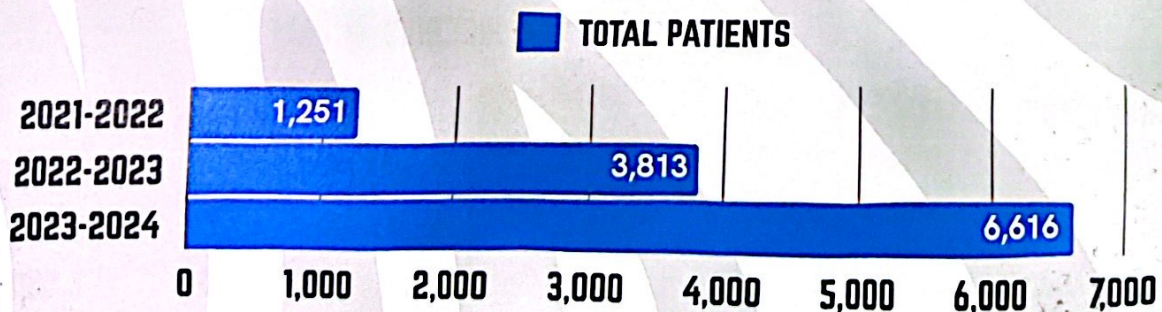
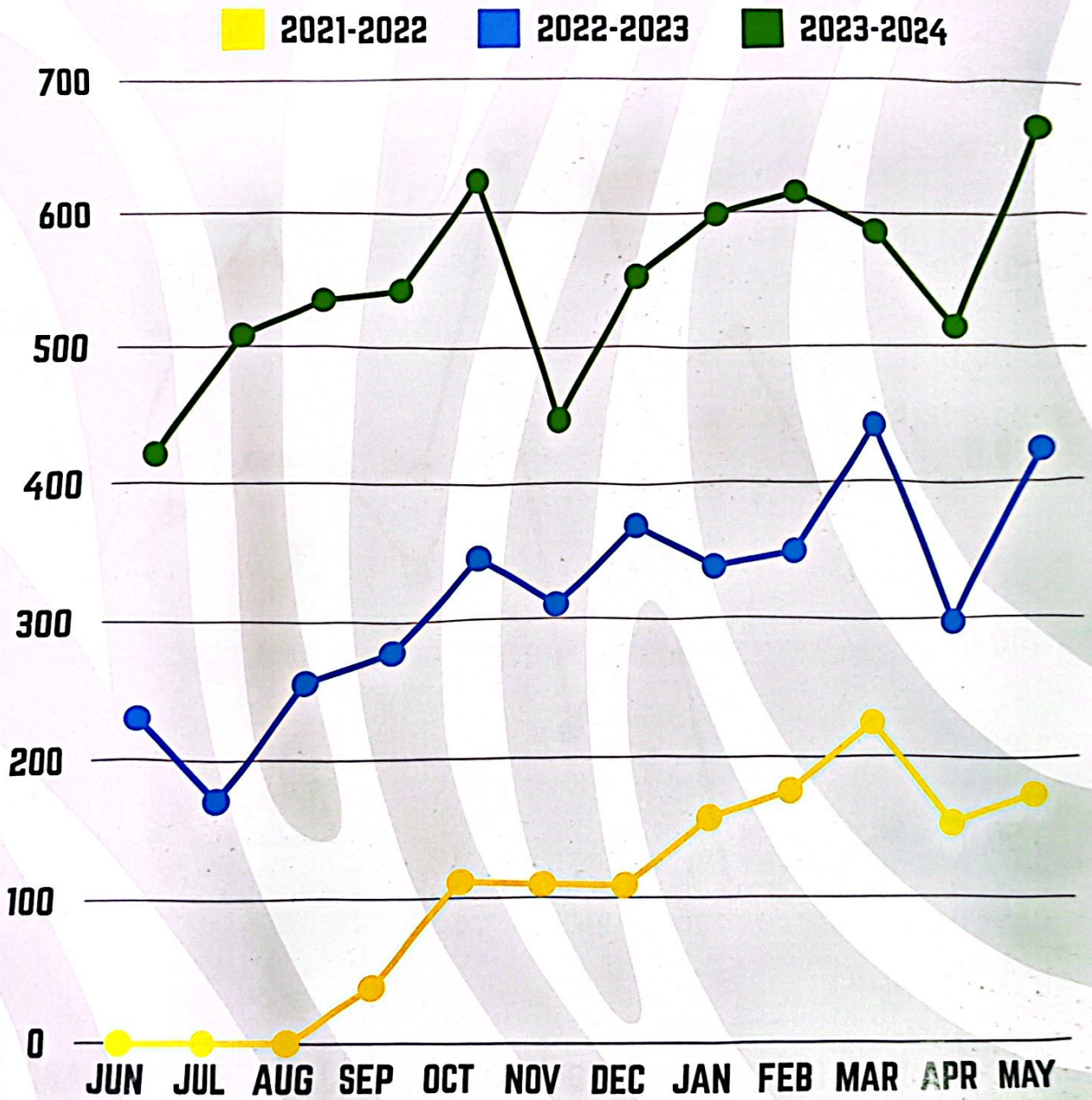

OCT-A DONATED BY DR AHMED HASSAM THROUGH WF-AID



Earlier in 2023, we received an incredible addition to our clinic: the Optical Coherence Tomography-Angiogram (OCT-A), only the second of its kind in the country. This state-of-the-art diagnostic machine was acquired thanks to a generous donor through the offices of WF-AID. We extend our heartfelt thanks to this visionary benefactor.

We began conducting OCT tests in August 2023, and in just 10 months, we have carried out 534 OCT tests. The OCT-A is a cutting-edge, non-invasive imaging tool that uses reflected light to create detailed images of the back of the eye, including the retina and optic nerve. Its significance lies in its ability to aid in the early diagnosis and management of conditions like diabetic retinopathy and glaucoma.

Diabetic retinopathy can be elusive in its early stages, making timely diagnosis vital. The OCT-A's high-resolution imaging allows us to detect even the slightest changes in the retina, enabling early intervention and preserving sight.

In the fight against glaucoma, the OCT-A machine plays a critical role. It offers precise monitoring, helping us catch and manage this progressive condition before it leads to irreversible blindness.

With this remarkable technology, KSI Charitable Eye Centre is better equipped than ever to provide patient-centered, affordable, superior eye care. We are committed to making a lasting impact on the lives of those we serve.

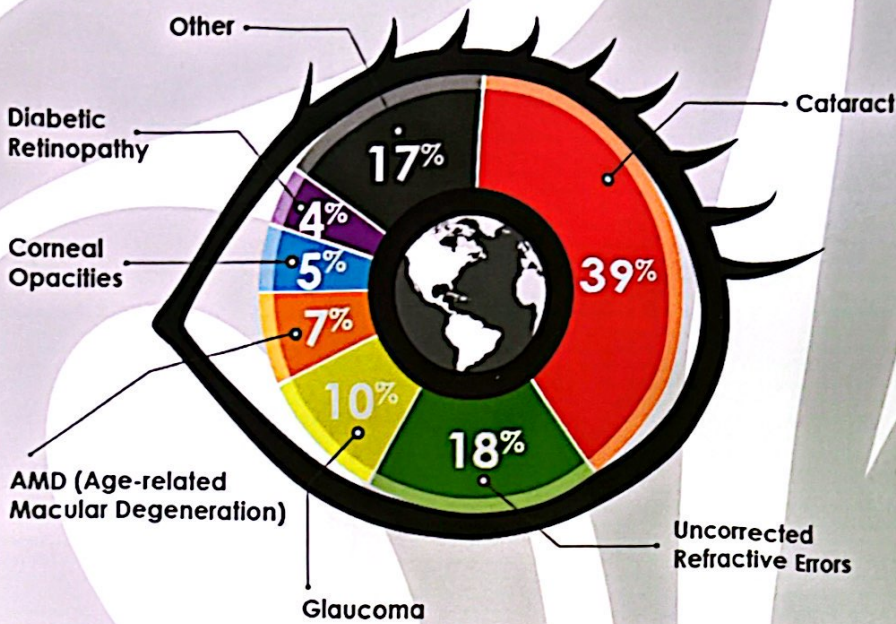


Leading Causes of Blindness Around the World
